Toronto - This afternoon there was a minor incident involving an aircraft with the Canadian Harvard Aerobatic Team at Pearson International Airport (PIA). After landing and while taxiing the aircraft ran off the runway but was quickly recovered by the pilot. Both individuals onboard are safe and without injury. Actions taken by the pilot and emergency response teams were in accordance with standard protocol.

After an initial assessment the aircraft was deemed to have an issue with its landing gear. It was then lifted from its position and taxied under its own power to the hangar.

Airport operations at PIA were not interrupted. Safety is paramount to the Canadian International Air Show and we are pleased to say the situation was handled with professionalism by all organizations involved. The Canadian International Air Show will continue Saturday, Sunday and Monday 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. as scheduled.
